## Our Philosophy

1. Build: volunteers and partner families build and repair homes with donated materials and labor
2. Finance: families pay for their home or repair with affordable financing terms
3. Reinvest: all mortgage and loan payments are reinvested back into more housing solutions



### HOME BUYER PROGRAM

Perspective Habitat home buyers must demonstrate a need for safe, decent and affordable housing, be able and willing to pay an affordable mortgage and be willing to invest "sweat-equity" into their home. In addition to working side by side with volunteers through the construction of their home, home buyers also complete financial literacy and homeowner education courses to help prepare them for owning a home.



### HOME REPAIR PROGRAM

Our Home Repair Program provides affordable financing for low to moderate income homeowners in need of home preservation or critical home repairs. Qualified homeowners complete "sweat-equity" and assist with their repairs as they are physically able.



### GLOBAL HOME BUILDING

Habitat for Humanity's vision is a world where everyone deserves a decent place to live. Habitat Lakeside supports this vision through an annual tithe to our international partners. We are committed to building one home internationally (average cost of \$4,500) for every home we build locally.



### ROCK THE BLOCK

Rock the Block is an event-based program that was initiated in partnership with the City of Sheboygan and the Sheboygan Police Department. The event brings together residents, municipalities and community partners to collectively improve targeted neighborhoods through the completion of exterior home repairs, community projects and lighting/sanitation/beautification activities.

### HABITAT RESTORE

Habitat for Humanity ReStores are nonprofit home improvement stores and donation centers that sell new and gently used furniture, appliances, home accessories and more to the public at a fraction of the retail price. Proudly owned and operated by Habitat for Humanity, our Sheboygan ReStore provides funding to the Habitat Lakeside mission, offers affordable home improvement items to the general public and diverts waste from landfills.
